Bank Vontobel uses Intra-GLOX Routing to send OTC-X Orders to BEKB | BCBE

Orders for [OTC-X](#) can now be sent via GLOX to the Berner Kantonalbank with Bank Vontobel successfully going live as the first pilot customer.

The orders are sent via the GLOX FIX Hub, which simplifies and reduces the number of connections required for your market connectivity. It also helps to manage release cycles for each connection. A [GLOX FIX Hub Connection](#) enables connectivity to a wide range of exchanges, brokers and alternative venues.

Neue Helvetische Bank & St.Galler Kantonalbank go live on GLOX Bloomberg Send

Three months after the successful migration to the GLOX platform (with SIX Swiss Exchange as their primary destination), the Neue Helvetische Bank have added a connection to Bloomberg EMSX. This will be followed by TSOX soon.

The St.Galler Kantonalbank also started using GLOX Bloomberg Send with EMSX in October. They have already been using TSOX for several years now.

GLOX Bloomberg Send is now in use at four customers with two further connections in the pipeline. From 2017 Bloomberg will introduce their new Multi-Asset Protocol (MAP) to provide a consolidated connection for EMSX and TSOX. MACD is already analysing the specifications and in line with our usual policy we will migrate existing customers free of charge in due course. New customers will be connected directly to MAP.

Notenstein La Roche Private Bank: External markets will be connected via GLOX

As part of their move from Apsys to Avaloq Notenstein La Roche Private Bank has decided to also connect their external markets via GLOX. In addition to the current SIX Swiss Exchange connection two brokers will be added as well as [GLOX Bloomberg Send](#). This will facilitate a marked increase in the level of STP (Straight Through Processing) for order routing and execution within the bank.

GLOX will route the orders to the correct exchange based on the security. As this model is already in operation at several other customers, Notenstein La Roche Private Bank will be able to benefit from the increased efficiency and reduced error rates already seen in similar configurations.

GLOX 9.0 Release live

As of the 14th November all customers are now live with GLOX 9.0. The release includes several new features of benefit for traders including configuration of security profiles and improved handling of filters with a single click. Additionally [Swiss@Mid](#) is now supported free of charge for all GLOX SIX Swiss Exchange members.

Project HTML5 Trading Client started

GLOX is celebrating it's 15th birthday this year and we are proud that it has been running successfully at our customers for all these years. In the longer term we have decided that an HTML5 based trading client is the best solution for future development. Our experienced MACD team has already started working on this project.
